Sales Restrictions

Just a reminder. According to MCA 23-7-302 (3), "Tickets and chances may be purchased only with cash or a check and may not be purchased on credit." The Montana Lottery has signs for you to use. Please contact your Sales or Tel-Sell Rep if you need some of these signs.

Scratch Reminders

Ticket orders: Once an order of Scratch games is delivered to your location, use either the enclosed invoice or a pack of tickets in the order to "receive" the order. This does not activate or settle the packs of tickets, but simply lets Lottery sales and security staff know that shipment has been successfully delivered to your location. The "Receive" function is available under the Scratch menu of your terminal.

Free Ticket winners: Some of the \$10 Scratch games, such as **Win It All**, offer a "\$10 Free Ticket" prize. This prize must be paid to the player in Scratch tickets, but any combination of Scratch tickets that adds up to \$10 is acceptable. It is tracked in your accounting reports as a \$10 Scratch pay. For example, if a player brings in a **Win It All** Scratch ticket that is a winner of a "\$10 Free Ticket," but you are not currently selling **Win It All**, the player can take that \$10 Scratch in another \$10 game or a combination of \$1, \$2 \$3 or \$5 tickets.

Pay Prizes Between \$100 and \$599.99

Paying Lotto and Scratch prizes is a major part of being a licensed Lottery retailer. Knowing the proper steps and terminal functions of paying prizes will make the transaction easier for you and quicker for your customer.

If a ticket worth between \$1 to \$100 is validated, the terminal will automatically produce a Pay Slip, and the transaction will appear in your Sales Summary Report under "Pays." When a ticket worth between \$101 and \$599.99 is validated, an extra step is required to ensure that you have enough cash on hand to pay the prize.

Press [PAY] to pay the prize and complete the transaction if you have enough funds to pay the larger prize amount.

Press [EXIT] if you do not have enough funds to pay the larger prize amount. It is important to give the ticket back to the player and let them know you cannot pay the prize. The player then has two options:

1. Take the winning ticket to another retailer that has enough funds to pay the prize.
2. Mail the winning ticket to Montana Lottery headquarters. Lottery staff will process the winning ticket and mail the player a check for the prize amount.
