Game Parameters update

1.) Update language in the Montana Sports Betting - Game Parameters to address how our system handles in-play wagers, with more details and descriptions for our offered MLB micro-markets.

Clarifying how our offered MLB in-play markets can be updated rather than voided depending on events occurring in the baseball game. Also addressing how our system handles the new MLB time violation rules.

Update language to the Baseball Wager types section(s), 1.6.15 through 1.6.18:

1.6 Baseball Wager types

1.6.15 All MLB Plate Appearance Markets

The market will void if the Plate Appearance does not occur in the same inning it was offered in.

If a runner is thrown out during an existing plate appearance and this out ends the inning, the markets for the ongoing plate appearance are voided and a new market will be created when the player comes up again in the following inning.

Markets are both inning- and pitcher- agnostic, meaning that they will not void if the plate appearance does not occur during the inning it was offered in or if there is a pitching substitution. They will get repriced and stay enabled instead until named batter appears at the plate. Void markets will occur only if the named pitcher does not appear for his numbered appearance due to game ending in the meantime.

1.6.15 15.1 MLB Plate Appearance Result Exact

Next Plate Appearance for Exact Player 1 A10 (=plate appearance of named batter)

Next Plate Appearance Result Exact are wagers on whether a batter's result of a plate appearance is a single, double, triple, home run, strikeout, walk/hit by pitch, in-play out, or reaches on error.

Catcher's interference results as a Reach on Error. Fielder's choices that do not result in outs are resulted as Reach on Error. A dropped 3rd strike counts as a Strikeout for the batter but doesn't count as an out if he reaches base safely. If the batter is ruled out while attempting to advance extra bases after a hit, the market will result according to what bases the batter was credited for prior to trying to extend for the extra bases.

1.6.16-15.2 MLB-Plate Appearance Result Grouped

Next Plate Appearance Result Player 1 A10 (=plate appearance of named batter)

Next Plate Appearance Result are wagers on whether a batter's result of a plate appearance is a hit, out, or walk.

Fielder's choices result as Out even if the batter reaches base. Reach on error and Hit by pitch voids the market. A dropped 3rd strike counts as an out for the batter but doesn't count as an out if he reaches base safely. If the batter is ruled out while attempting to advance extra bases after a hit, the market will result as Hit.

1.6.17 15.3 MLB Plate Appearance On Reach Base

Next Plate Appearance Base Player 1 A10 (=plate appearance of named batter)

Next Plate Appearance Reach Base are wagers on whether a batter will be on base or out as a result of his plate appearance.

If the batter is ruled out while attempting to advance extra bases after a hit, the market will result as No (not on base).

1.6.18-15.4 MLB-Next Plate Appearance Pitch Count and Pitch Result

Next Plate Appearance Pitch Count Player 1 A10 (=plate appearance of named batter)

Next Plate Appearance Pitch Count is a wager on how many pitches the batter will face within a plate appearance.

<u>Automatic strikes and automatic balls are not taken into account for pitch count.</u> Intentional walks void the pitch count and future individual pitch markets. <u>Hit by Pitch results as a Ball.</u>

1.6.15.5 Next Plate Appearance Pitch Result

Next Plate Appearance Pitch Count Player 1 A10 (=plate appearance of named batter)

Pitch Result is a wager on whether the pitch will result in a strike/foul, ball, or in-play.

Hit by Pitch results as a ball.
