MONTANA LOTTERY COMMISSION TO MEET

The Montana Lottery's next scheduled commission meeting will be held on Thursday, December 8, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. The meeting will take place at Lottery Headquarters and by video conference call. The meeting is open to the public. The Lottery Commission consists of five members appointed to four-year staggered terms by the Governor. Current Commissioners are Jon Metropoulos, Helena; Leo Prigge, Butte; Tony Harbaugh, Miles City; Steve Morris, Helena; and Dwaine Iverson of Shelby.

Lottery Commissioners are responsible for determining policies for the operation of the Lottery and considering recommendations of Lottery staff in the types and forms of games offered, as well as percentages of prizes paid and price of each ticket or chance sold.

The Montana Lottery was created by referendum in 1986. Since then, it has paid over \$775 million in prizes and returned approximately \$302 million to the State of Montana.
